### 1. Leisure time activities

The towns and villages in the canton have a large number of interesting **cycling routes** (marked with red-brown signs). In Baar (Rathaus) and Zug (Bundesplatz), you can borrow a bicycle or a trottinett free of charge between 9 a.m. and 9 p.m. from the beginning of May until the end of October. Bikes can also be borrowed free of charge in Cham (town hall, Mandelhof). All you need to do is deposit personal identification.

The "Zug Tourismus" office publishes an information and excursion brochure. On the Zug Tourismus website, you will also find tips and ideas for **sightseeing and excursions** in the canton, e.g. hiking routes, bike tours, trips by boat or guided tours. The canton's own website also provides information about various leisure time activities.

There are three **cinemas** in Zug which show most films in the original language with German and French undertitles. The Internet page provides information about the movies, but you can also find the same information in the daily newspapers or the Amtsblatt (which appears on Fridays).

Saturday is **weekly market day** in a number of municipalities - on the Landsgemeindeplatz at the lake in Zug, at the town hall ("Rathaus") in Baar, on the village squares in Cham and Hünenberg, on the Dorfmattpplatz in Rotkreuz and on the ZVB grounds in Oberägeri. You can find up-to-date information at your local town hall, in the daily newspapers, the Amtsblatt or the culture calendar of the Canton of Zug.

In various municipalities, there are **fairgrounds** at certain times of the year. These events always attract lots of people who enjoy buying and having fun. There is a fairground alongside the lake in Zug at Easter and Whitsun. Here again, information can be found in the daily press, the Amtsblatt or the culture calendar.
